WHAT IS THIS SURVEY? 1/2

- As part of the final project in my PT204 Pastoral Theology class at <u>St. Vladimir's</u> <u>Seminary</u>, I created a survey asking Orthodox priests and deacons their opinions on 50 sites in the "Orthodox Internet": News Aggregators, Multiauthor Blogs, Single-author Blogs, Podcasts, and Video Channels.
- Each respondent was asked to rate each site in four categories: **1. Full Recommendation** 2. Partial Recommendation 3. Do Not Recommend
 - 4. Unknown



WHAT IS THIS SURVEY? 2/2

- I also asked demographic questions and three open-ended questions: 1. What is the best site you recommend to inquirers and catechumens? 2. What site would you remove from the internet, if possible? 3. What is the biggest parish ministry challenge related to "Internet Orthodoxy"?
- Orthodox clergy from multiple jurisdictions and regions of the country.
